Always Praying . . .

- ♦ The church must have a persistent focus on prayer (Acts 1:13-14).
- ♦ Example: The church must seek God's direction in choosing leadership (Acts 1:21-26).
- ♦ The church must pray concerning major decisions (Acts1:21).
- ♦ The church should be devoted to prayer (Acts 2:42).
- ♦ Example: The persecuted church prays (Acts 4:31).
- ♦ Example: The church's prayers should focus on the bold proclamation of the Word (Acts 4:31).
- ♦ The church must turn to fervent prayer during difficult seasons (Acts 12:4-5).
- ♦ The church should fast and pray when embarking on a large mission (Acts 13:1-3).
- The church planter should pray and fast when considering leaving the church in the hand of the developed leadership (Acts 14:23).
- ♦ The church should pray (Acts 20:36).
- The church members should be devoted to prayer (Romans 12:12).
- The church should pray that they will be given unity and like mindedness according to Christ (Romans 15:5).
- ♦ The church must give constant attention to prayer (Col 4:2).
- ♦ The church must keep alert in its prayers with an attitude of thanksgiving (Col 4:2).
- ♦ The church should pray for other ministries that they would have opportunities to share the mystery of Christ (Col 4:3).
- ♦ The church should pray for other ministries to speak clearly the words of the Gospel (Col 4:3).
- ♦ The church should pray that we would speak the words of the Gospel clearly (Col 4:4).
- The church leaders should pray that the members will receive the Word of God as the Word of God (I Thess 2:13).
- ♦ The church members must pray without ceasing (I Thess 5:17).
- ♦ The church must pray (I Thess 5:21).
- The church leadership must pray for God to make church members worthy of His calling (II Thess 1:11).
- The church leadership must pray for God to fulfill the desires of goodness and works of faith and power that the church members have (II Thess 1:12)
- ♦ The church must pray for the word of the Lord to spread rapidly and be glorified (II Thess 3:1).
- ♦ The church should make entreaties, prayers and thanksgivings to God on behalf of all men (I Tim 2:1).
- The church should pray for the salvation of rulers and authorities so that we may lead a tranquil and quiet life (I Tim 2:2).
- The church should pray for all men because God desires all men to be saved through His one Mediator (I Tim 2:5-7).
- The men in the church should pray with a pure heart without an angry spirit (I Tim 2:8).
- ♦ The church members must pray for the church leaders to have a good conscience and live honorably in all things (Heb 13:18-21).
